Summary of the Assembly Content

1. Ramadan

Summary of the Assembly Content

6. Black History Month

The assembly video considers the reasons for Black History Month. The whole assembly will promote awareness of the achievements of Black people and reflect on how they helped change the world and attitudes.

7. Remembrance Day

The focus of the assembly video is the poppy legend and how the poppy became the symbol of remembrance not only for soldiers who have died in the World Wars but other wars involving British soldiers.

8. World AID Day

The slogan 'Don't die of ignorance' is as relevant today as it was in the 1980s. The assembly video considers the reasons for World Aids Day and raises awareness of HIV/AIDS, its global impact and prevention.

9. Human Rights Day

The assembly video will help pupils to understand the concept of 'human rights', to consider the reasons for a Human Rights Day and that everyone receives them and they should respect the rights of others.

10. Holocaust Memorial Day

'The Same but different' is the theme of this assembly. The assembly video considers the history of Jewish persecution by the Nazis and the tragedy of the Holocaust. It also reflects on prejudice and discrimination.
